Kairos Moments . . .

Reflections of Reverend Pamela Moyer

What an amazing Sunday! Thank you as I said on the cover to all who participated in and prepared for a delicious Installation Luncheon and Worship Service. It was like an episode of the old television show "This Is Your Life!" Five churches (3 former and 2 present) were represented that day, plus friends and family. I was touched by how you all made an effort to welcome and get to know each other!

There were many moving parts so I don't have room to thank each of you by name, but please accept my heartfelt gratitude for your time, your prayers and your affirmation! I felt appreciated, loved and empowered by the kind words, hugs, the people who chose to attend, delicious food, beautiful cake, cards and gifts.

In the morning church service we talked about the Ascension of Jesus, and last week about the coming Advocate. This was Jesus' mild reprimand to the disciples in Acts 1:6-8:

⁶ So when they had come together, they asked him, 'Lord, is this the time when you will restore the kingdom to Israel?' ⁷ He replied, ⁷ 'it is not for you to know the times or periods that the Father has set by his own authority. ⁸ But you will receive power when the Holy Spirit has come upon you; and you will be my witnesses in Jerusalem, in all Judea and Samaria, and to the ends of the earth.'

Jesus corrects them to make the point that their work will fail if they try to accomplish this commission on their own strength and merit. Yet, if they rely on him through the power of the coming Holy Spirit, they can do all things through Christ . . . That is what I heard Rev. Lisa Cole Smith conveying in her Installation Message, "We Got Skills." Like the disciples, we have history, experience, faith stories and oh, yes, the teachings of Jesus! We do not need to fear the future; God is with us, the Holy Spirit is here (next week is observation of Pentecost, so wear *red* if you'd like!) and Jesus through the Scriptures has taught us leadership, evangelism, hospitality and life skills! We at UBC need to accept our giftedness, mission and our vision and live into it! Together!

June Health Focus



Alzheimer's disease is a progressive, degenerative disorder that attacks the brain's nerve cells, or neurons, resulting in loss of memory, thinking and language skills, and behavioral changes. Alzheimer's disease is the most common cause of dementia, loss of intellectual function, among people aged 65 and older. Alzheimer's disease is not a normal part of aging. Symptoms vary and gradually increase and become more persistent. The common warning signs include:

- Memory loss, especially of recent events, names, placement of objects, and other new information
- Confusion about time and place
- Struggling to complete familiar actions, such as brushing teeth or getting dressed
- Trouble finding the appropriate words, completing sentences, and following directions and conversations
- Poor judgment when making decisions
- Changes in mood and personality, such as increased suspicion, rapid and persistent mood swings, withdrawal, and disinterest in usual activities
- Difficulty with complex mental assignments, such as balancing a checkbook or other tasks involving numbers

If you notice these symptoms, please contact your heath care provider. Although there is no cure, behavioral management intervention and medications can be used alone or in combination, and may help slow progression of symptoms and improve quality of life.
